For the academic year Sept 2015-2016 we received £8,905.

We used our PE and Sports provision this academic year to:

- Buy in specialist PE teachers to assist in the upskilling of staff and also to deliver high quality PE in KS2.
- Provide CPD opportunities for teaching staff.
- Purchasing a number of resources so as to enable children to experience a wide range of sports
- Prepare and attend Healthy Active Lifestyle Events and Festivals
- Prepare and attend Competitive Opportunities.
- Ensure there is a comprehensive program of Extra-Curricular Activities made available to all children.
- Provided Cycling lessons in order to support the school's long-term vision for cycling.
