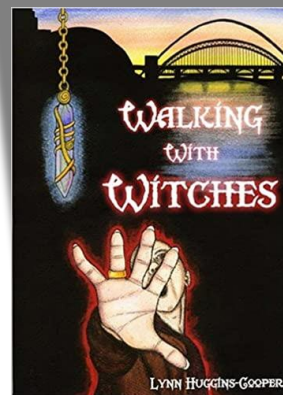
- Recognise the work of the Holy Spirit to enable people to hear God's message.
