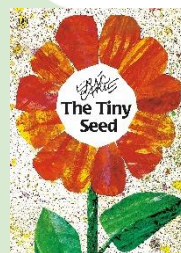

What happens when plants grow?

English

Narrative: We will be looking at the classic traditional tale of Rapunzel, exploring different versions and looking at it as a 'quest'.

Non-fiction: We will be writing steps to help us complete a familiar process. We will try out recipes, construction instructions and following different types of instructions.

Multiplication and division

- Solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher

Fractions

- Recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity
- Recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity

- Describe position, direction and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns

Learn about all the different parts of trees and flowers.

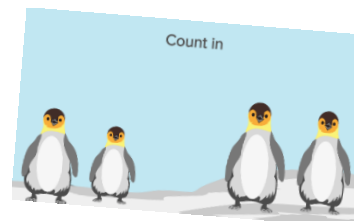
History
